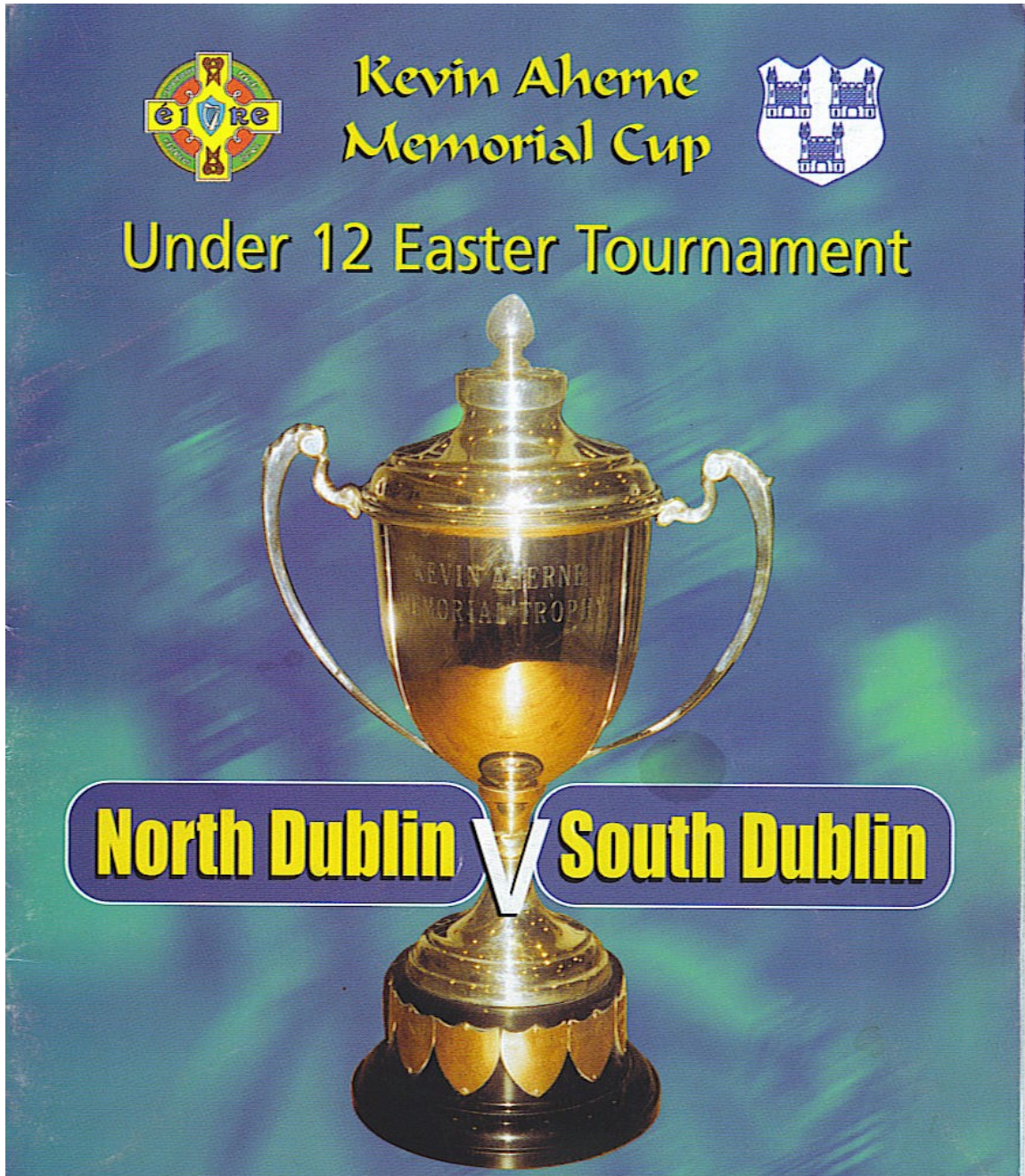

Rules of the Competition

1. 2010 Go Games Rules apply.
2. All kick outs to be taken from the 20m line and from the hand.
3. Free kicks and 45s to be taken from the hand.
4. In the event of a tie in a section, aggregate scores will decide who goes through, i.e. scores **for**, **minus** scores **against** and if equal, the team with the greater number of scores **for** will go through.
5. In the event of a semi final ending in a draw, an extra 5 minutes each half is played. If the outcome is still unresolved, each team will take 5 penalties and scores added as in the section rules. If still equal, continue until sudden death.
6. In the event of the final ending in a draw, the same rules as in the semi finals will apply.
